iPhone Apps for Shooting:

Pro HDR: camera app for shooting very High Definition pictures.

Hipstamatic: camera app for shooting pictures that gives you a square format made for Instagram, with a funky border & lenses that distort to varying degrees. User picks a combination of lens & film you want to use. Tap "star" at bottom, this brings up "favorites", tap "plus" button to create new favorites. It will display your choices, such as the lens, flash type, the film type, & the camera case. I personally like "John S/Dream Pop/Kodot-XGrizzled Film." You save your favorites, then when you open the camera again, this becomes your working set-up. Shoot the picture with the yellow button or by tapping screen. To view them, look in lower left for a little window where pic appears and tap; saves pic into their own gallery plus to your iPhone camera roll. The pictures are labeled in terms of what film, lens etc. you used so you can easily find your favorite combination again.

Fisheye Lens: camera app for shooting pictures: 8mm lens is my favorite; "Aperture" is where you find different lenses; you can add flash; best to keep filters on "Standard."

iPhone Apps for Editing:

Snapseed: Main Picture Editing and Processing App, has a great HDR plus selective adjustments and useful, interesting filters, such as; HDR Scape, Drama, Glamour Glow, Tonal Contrast, and Black and White; Tools: Vignette, Selective Adjustment (only App with that), Tune Image. When you are finished select "save a copy" so your original image remains untouched.

Photoshop Express: Main Picture Editing and Processing App, I like this because it has the best de-noising feature and the easiest to use sharpening feature, plus really good filters to apply over photos (they call them looks) like Vibrant, Summer, Autumn, Bueno, Dappled, Dream, Glow, Pastel, plus B&W filters. Allows you to de-noise and sharpen by enlarging photo so you can see in-detail; Also has a good spot remover called blemish removal.

Go to Camera Roll, select a photo, and it opens at right

Tiny Planets: Special Effects App, plus camera, one of a kind; can shoot in "Tiny Planet" but you don't have to; choose from the photo album or camera roll. There are two ways to manipulate your image; *tiny planet* or *rabbit hole*. *Tiny planet* gives a global/spherical image, and *rabbit hole* does the opposite, giving you a sinkhole look. The bottom area of the photo becomes the center of the photo in tiny planet, and the edges become the center in rabbit hole.

Waterlogue: Special Effects App, Watercolor, imitates watercolor painting: Shoot a photo in the app or go to your camera roll. The app immediately draws it for you, creating a watercolor effect. You can then adjust the effect with various filters. Natural is default filter, plus Travelogue, Luminous, and Color Bloom. Tap "heart" button to save.

TinType: Special Effects App, plus camera, that creates End of 19th century look; You can shoot a photo in the app or select one from your camera roll. The app works best in the black and white modes.

PaperCamera: Special Effects App, plus camera, shoot a photo in the app or go to your camera roll. This app gives uses very abstract pop art filters like Comic Boom and Sketch Book. The effect is like drawing on paper.

Framatic: Special Effects App, for creating mosaics and frames, pick to create mosaics or a framed look for your photo like wood or metal: pick one of their formats, put whatever pix you want in it, different borders, can put four pix in all of them

Instafit: Special Effects App, for Fitting various sized photos into the Instagram square format, if you want to post on Instagram a photo that isn't a square and can't be cropped as a square, it takes it and makes it a square by putting it against a background that is square;

Over: Special Effects App, for writing and captioning pictures, for putting type into your photo, for writing over

Instagram: This is a photo-based social media site based on instantly sharing your photos during the day, and it uses a square format. Open it up and get news feed like on Facebook. All the people you are following show up with their photos. To upload a photo, you tap the camera button that is the middle icon and you get the ability to take a photo, or you tap on the lower left and you will see the last photo you took. You tap on that and it will show your whole photo gallery. You select the one you want. You go thru Instagram's filters to see if they improve your photo, but if your photo is already processed you may not want them.
