Suggested supplies for class:

Bring at least two supports to class. Suggested supports: Canvas, Watercolor Paper and/or Crescent Illustration Board.

One 18" x 24" Canson XL Watercolor Pad or Mixed Media Pad (30 sheets) from Jerry's or Dick Blick. You can often find one of these at Michael's and use a 50% coupon to purchase.

You need to bring a water container.

Paper towels and/or rags

Rubbing alcohol

Freezer paper (available at grocery store) or whatever palette you have to mix paints Apron

Plastic/Latex gloves

Sponges

Small plastic palette knife for mixing paints

White gesso
