

VIRTUAL Collage & Mixed Media Supply List

Start with a Canvas or Board.... Any Size You Like!

1. To make a collage...You will need elements to work with... Personal Photos or **Pictures** you want to collage ... magazines, newspapers, greetings cards, colored papers, tissue papers, etc.... bring lots!

2. Art Supplies....

A set of acrylic paints / primary colors + black and white / or more Assorted size paint brushes for acrylic fine art painting, Bring assorted brushes, sponges and/or textures that you may have or want to use. Scissors, Pencils, Sharpies, and matte knife.

3. Sealers and Glues...to Attach your Elements.

Large Size Hot Glue Gun, with Full Size "Long" Glue Sticks... Full size is most practical. Elmer's Glue, "Modge Podge" Gloss Medium and or Matte Medium is a Must Have! Masking tape and or scotch tape

4. Optional! Anything You Like to Use To Make Art! Both 2 & 3-Dimensional! Newspapers, magazine pages, copies of photos color or black & white, tissue paper, found objects, found papers, tickets, Glitter, menus, maps, printing, etc. for collaging and transfers, stencils, stamps, inks, oil pastels, graphite pencils, sandpaper...

Recyclables are best, you don't have to buy out the store!!! For texture or 3-D you can use Egg cartons, plastic caps, labels, wire, toilet paper tubes, paper towel tubes, wood ice cream sticks etc....
