- You also should find at least one skin tone Prismacolor marker that you prefer

- My favorite book is <u>9 Heads: A guide to Drawing Fashion</u>, if you would like to purchase your own copy, I will refer to it in class. This is not a mandatory item, just recommended.
- Tracing light box this will make it easy for you to trace figures and draw over your croquis after moving on from tracing paper.
- Colored pencils and markers We will briefly touch on using color, so you may want to make the investment in them now for your future use.
